Memorial Day Parade-Cancelled

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, and the governor's orders, the 2020 Memorial Day parade has been cancelled.

Cemetery Services-Monday May 25

The Legion Honor Guard will meet at the Post 297 hall Monday May 25, 9:30 a.m. and leave at 10 a.m. for Sullivan Cemetery. Upon arrival, we will march into the cemetery, have the chaplain offer a prayer, then read the list of war veterans buried in Sullivan Township Cemetery. We then have a rifle salute and Taps.

The Honor Guard will then proceed to Moorland Cemetery, Seaman Cemetery, Hilton Cemetery and St. Catherine Cemetery with a short prayer, rifle salute and taps at each stop.

The Honor Guard will then proceed to the Ravenna Township Cemetery for the same service with the addition of a reading of the list of Ravenna area veterans killed in the great wars.

The final stop will be at the Main Street bridge where a short service will be held to include the ceremonial tossing of the wreath into Crockery Creek.
