# Memorial Day...

**Parade...** will assemble **Monday May 30,** 9:30 a.m. at the Legion Hall; officer of the Day-Mike Pierson; parade coordinator Jenny Kruszynski.

Legion honor guard will lead the parade starting at 10 a.m. followed by Grand Marshall-Korean War Veteran Merle Bonter, veterans, and the Ravenna School band. Parade travels east up Stafford Street to Main Street where the band will stop as the honor guard turns south to the Main Street bridge. Once the honor guard is set up at the bridge, the band will play the national anthem. Following the national anthem, there will be a ceremonial wreath toss into Crockery Creek by the grand marshal, a prayer, gun salute and taps.

Memorial Service-The parade then travels north to the Ravenna Cemetery entrance and turns right (east) to the stage area for a memorial service. The Ravenna band will play several numbers including a medley of military service songs. There will be a commemoration of the service men from Ravenna that lost their lives in the wars and conflicts, a wreath laying at the Civil War memorial, rifle salute and taps.

Note... We need golf carts, 4-wheelers, Gators, etc. for the parade. Be up at the Hall at 9:30 p.m. if you can help, Thanks! Free Hot Dog Dinner following the parade at the Legion Hall. Drawings will be held for the Legion rifle and Sons pistol. Officer in charge-Jim Redding.

**Cemetery Salutes-**will be **Sunday May 30**. We will meet at the Legion hall 12:30 p.m., leave at 12:45 p.m. for a salute at Sullivan Cemetery at 1 p.m. to include prayer, rifle salute and taps; then repeat at Moorland, Seaman, Hilton and St. Catherine cemeteries

*Memorial Day Set Up*-will be Monday May 30; meet at the hall at 7 a.m. to load up chairs to be set up in the Ravenna Township Cemetery for the memorial service. Members will have breakfast together at the Round Table Restaurant, 8 a.m.

Memorial Day (originally known as Decoration Day) is a federal holiday in the United States for mourning the U.S. military personnel who have died while serving in the United States armed forces. It is observed on the last Monday of May.
