<u>Beechnau Elementary School</u> Patriotism Project in Second Year

The Ravenna American Legion Post 297 has sponsored a Patriotism program at Beechnau Elementary School. The Post has purchased 3 sets of patriotic comic books that have been used to teach elementary students about our flag, veterans and military service.

In the 2021-2022 school year, the Post sponsored an essay contest for elementary students with 3 prizes for each of a dozen classes. An assembly was held in the spring where winners were awarded a gift certificate to Ink-Link for Bulldog apparel and all students were given an American flag.

In the 2022-2023 school year, one hour per month is devoted to instruction and discussion about patriotism. Each month a different topic is discussed. The school held a Constitution Day in September 17th where class time was devoted to learning about the U.S. Constitution. The December topic is Core Values, January-Branches of the Service, February-The Flag, April-Wars, May-Holidays.

A new comic book is ordered for this year "Our Country's Veterans".

An essay contest will be held for 3rd & 4th graders in March with an assembly set for Friday March 24, 1:30 p.m. *Officer in charge of the project is Debbie Vetter.*
